## **Overview of Travel and Objectives**

Minister Eyre travelled to Ottawa, ON to highlight Saskatchewan's concerns regarding Bill C-69 and reinforce our opposition to the legislation, as it was before the Senate. The travel provided an opportunity to present Saskatchewan's case against the bill to Senators and federal counterparts while also sharing our message with national media.

### **Travel Activity:**

During the travel, Minister Eyre met with ISG and Conservative Senators to discuss and lobby against Bill C-69, *The Impact Assessment Act*. The meetings provided an opportunity to highlight Saskatchewan's concerns with Bill C-69, including its impacts on Saskatchewan's energy and resource sector as well as overall economic competitiveness.

Minister Eyre also met with the Minister of Natural Resources Canada, the Honourable Amarjeet Sohi, to further discuss our concerns with Bill C-69.

In Ottawa, Minister Eyre also had several opportunities to share our concerns with national media outlets and publications.
