Overview of Travel and Objectives

The Saskatchewan delegation attended the Provincial Territorial Ministers Responsible for Local Government annual meeting in Dartmouth from June 11-13, 2019.

Travel Activity:

The following topics were discussed at the annual meeting:

- legalization of cannabis and the impacts on municipalities; and,
- climate change and disaster mitigation, potential partnerships in confronting climate change, best practices for disaster response and programs for disaster mitigation.

There was also a conference call discussion with the Federal Minister that addressed the following topics:

- the lack of flexibility of infrastructure programs;
- the need for more funding in the Disaster Mitigation and Adaptation Fund; and,
- the federal overreach into provincial jurisdiction and the lack of consultation with provincial governments in program development.
