

# Apply Online for Federal-Provincial Fellowship Scholarship and Travel Scholarship

You will need:

- a computer or other electronic device with internet connection;
- an active email address;
- the ability to scan/take pictures to submit documents electronically;
- your Social Insurance Number (SIN); and
- your banking information.

## How To Apply

1. Log into the computer (if applicable).  
Open any internet browser and use the search words “Saskatchewan Account Login”.  
The first link should bring you to <https://services.saskatchewan.ca/#/login>.

2. If you don’t have an account, click “Create Account” and then click “Create Individual Account”.

You must have an active email account to apply online.

If you already have an account, skip to step 7.

3. Follow the instructions to create a Saskatchewan account and submit.
4. You’ll receive an email to activate your account. Check your email inbox for a verification email and click the link activate your account. If you don’t see the email, check you junk

5. Sign into your account either your username or email and password.
6. Complete all the application questions and upload the supporting documents, such as a copy of your Social Insurance Number, Direct Deposit Form and Confirmation of Enrolment.
7. You can access your online application 24 hours a day, and save and exit at any time.

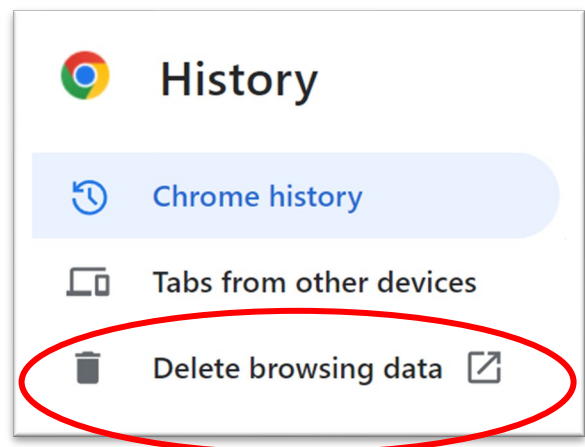

**Protect your identity** – After you're finished, always remember to use the sign out function from your *saskatchewan.ca* account, clear history/cookies and close the browser completely.

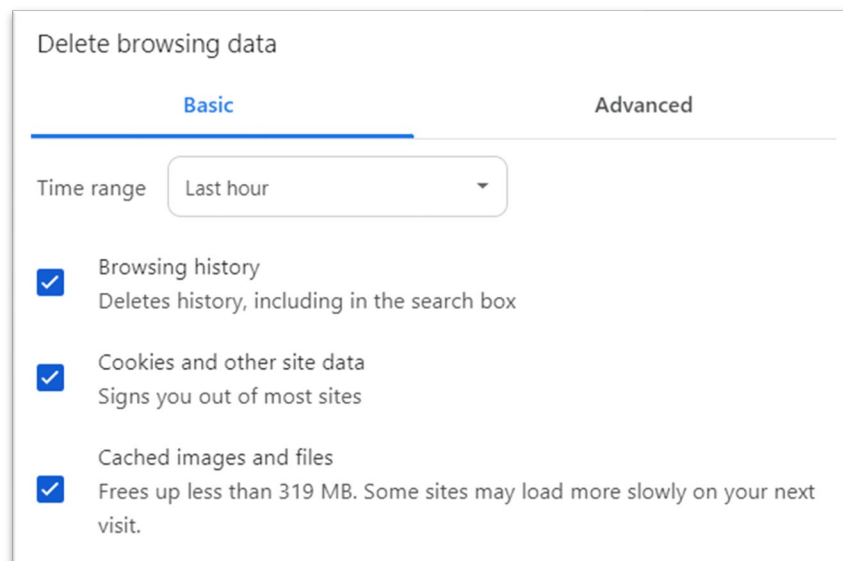
# Google Chrome – Clearing Browser History, Cache and Cookies

When using any public computer, you need to make sure your personal information isn't stored in the computer's memory. You can clear this information in Google Chrome by following the steps below. The process is similar in other internet browsers.

1. Select "Tools" via the three dots icon on the top right > History > History
2. Select "Clear Browsing Data" from the left side of the screen.



3. Check Browsing History, Cookies and Other Site Data, and Cached Images and Files. Click Clear Data.



4. Close the browser.
