Introduction

To assist motorists in locating Regional Parks in the province, the Ministry may install trailblazer signs at the turnoff to the park access.

Policy

At the request of the applicable Regional Park, the Ministry may install the IS-65 symbol in advance of the Regional Park Access.

Application

Application will be made to the ministry on a standard application form for evaluation. This form can be found in the Roadside Management Manual (RSMM) Part II, 1110-40 or 1170 and on the Ministry's website

Eligibility

The Regional Park must be a member in good standing of the Saskatchewan Regional Parks Association.

In order for a Regional Park to be eligible for official signing, it must meet the following criteria:

- The park will be open to the general public for recreational or cultural activities.
- The park will be open to the general public from at least 9:00 a.m. to dusk, seven days a week between Victoria Day and Labour Day weekend.
- When the park is solely a winter park it will be open from at least 10:00 a.m. to dusk, six days a week, during the winter recreation season.

The sign assembly should be installed approximately two hundred metres in advance of the access, when practical.

Signing of the access will consist of:

- The Regional Park Symbol;
- A directional arrow;
- A distance tab showing the distance to the park if it is not visible from the highway;
- A name tab identifying the Park and,
- A Closed tab if the park is not operational for a full 12 month period. Placement of the tab will be the responsibility of the park. Note: The Closed tab may be installed on the Advance sign instead.

Cost**Access Signing**

The cost of signing at the access point will be borne by MHI.

Additional information on Access signing costs is located in RSMM Part II, 1050-10.

Sign Removal

Signs may be removed if, in the opinion of the Ministry, the conditions of the policy are not being met.

Modifications/Relocation

If modifications are requested after installation, the applicant will be charged at a cost as described in the RSMM Part II Sign Pricing Policy 1050-10. If relocation is requested, the applicant will be charged the Ministry's actual relocation cost.
