



6800 - 1 DESCRIPTION

- 1.01 The work shall consist of revising and surfacing existing approaches in conformity with the lines, grades, and dimensions shown on the plans or designated by the Engineer.
- 1.02 Approaches shall include surveyed road approaches, approaches to farmsteads, field approaches, median crossings, and commercial and industrial approaches.

6800 - 2 MATERIALS

- 2.01 Earth material shall be obtained from sources designated by the Engineer. Earth material shall be free from organic or other objectionable material.
- 2.02 Traffic gravel, sub-base course, base course, bituminous surface course, oil treatment, or seal coat placed on approaches shall conform to the specification for the respective commodity.
- 2.03 The Department will supply and pay for culvert materials.

6800 - 3 CONSTRUCTION

- 3.01 The Engineer will designate the approaches which are to be finished with bituminous surface course. All other approaches will be finished with earth material, traffic gravel, sub-base course, base course, oil treatment, or seal coat.
- 3.02 Existing culverts shall be extended if necessary. The work shall be performed on an Extra Work basis.
- 3.03 Approaches shall be raised with earth material, as staked by the Engineer. The work shall be performed on an Extra Work basis.
- 3.04 Traffic gravel shall be placed in accordance with the requirements of the specification for Traffic Gravel (Specification 4300).
- 3.05 The surfacing material shall generally be dumped and spread on the approach at the same time that the corresponding lift of material is dumped and spread on the adjacent section of road.
- 3.06 Sub-base course, base course, and surface courses shall be placed in accordance with the requirements of the specification for the commodity used.
- 3.07 Prime coat shall be placed on the finished final lift of base course in accordance with the requirements for Bituminous Prime, Tack, and Flush Coat (Specification 4000).
- 3.08 Material used in raising approaches shall not be spread, spilled, or dumped on the main road surface. The Contractor shall repair, at no direct expense to the Department, any damage caused by his operation.

6800 - 4 MEASUREMENT

- 4.01 The commodities used will be measured in accordance with the requirements of their respective specifications.

6800 - 5 PAYMENT

- 5.01 Payment for extending culverts will be on an Extra Work basis.
- 5.02 Payment for earthwork on approaches will be on an Extra Work basis.
- 5.03 Payment for sub-base course, base course, and surface courses will be at the contract unit prices in accordance with the requirements of the specification for the commodity used. The unit prices will be full compensation for hand placing.
- 5.04 Payment for prime coat will be in accordance with the requirements for Bituminous Prime, Tack, and Flush Coat (Specification 4000).
