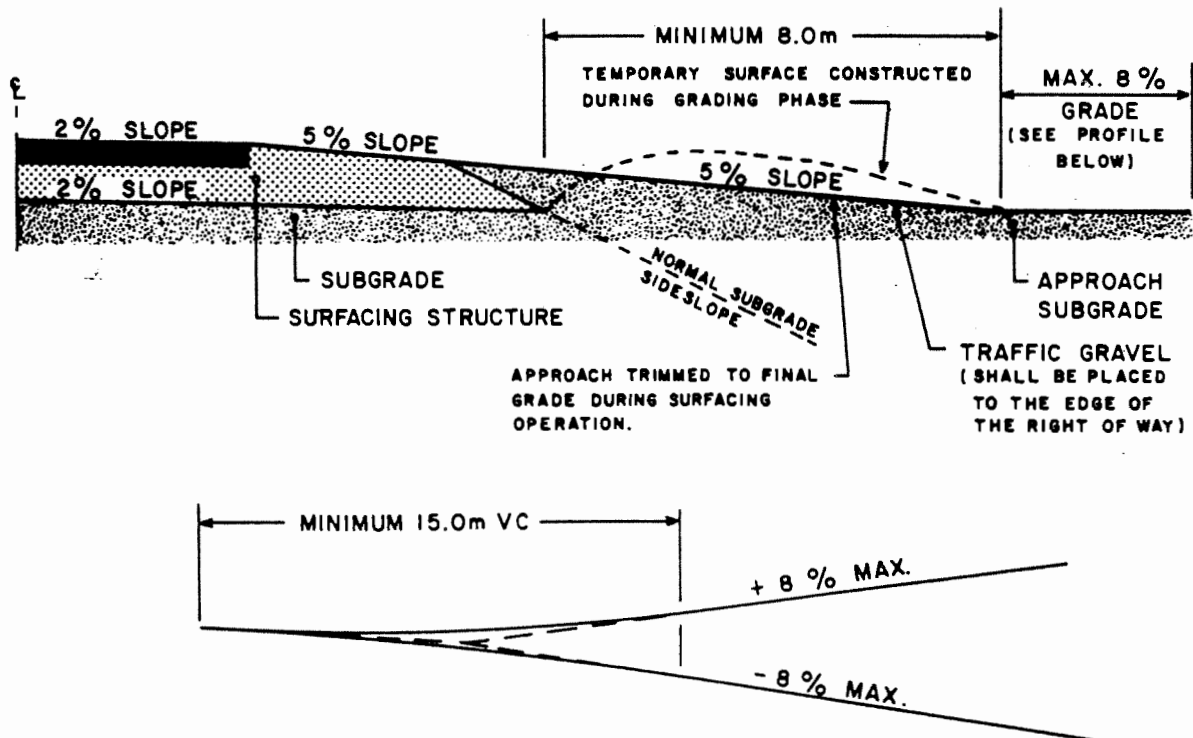
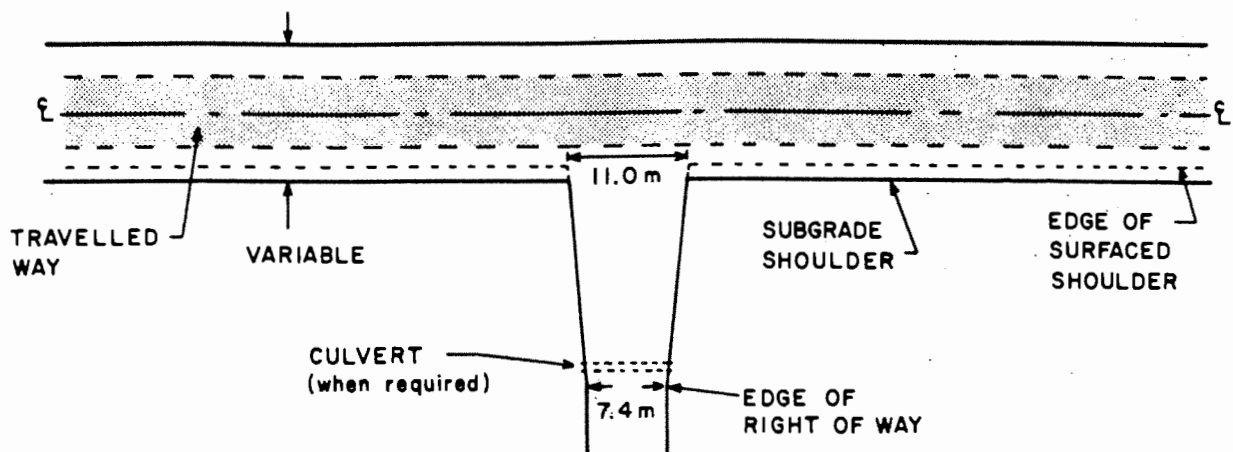


- NOTES:**
- (1) PAVED CLASS HIGHWAY MEANS A HIGHWAY WITH A PAVEMENT "B" OR HIGHER TYPE SURFACE.
 - (2) APPROACH SIDESLOPES ARE AS FOLLOWS:
 - 6:1 to $h = 3\text{m}$
 - variable sideslopes $h = 3\text{m}$ to 9m
 - use 2:1 sideslope when $h > 9\text{m}$
 - (3) APPROACH SUBGRADE SURFACE SHALL HAVE A CROWN OF 4%
