Introduction

To assist motorists in locating Provincial Parks Visitor centres, the Ministry may install directional signs in advance of the visitor centre.

Policy

At the request from the Ministry responsible for Provincial Parks, the Ministry may install the Visitor Centre signs along Provincial Highways in advance of the Centre's access.

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Section:**Information****Subject:****Provincial Park Visitor Center****Eligibility**

In order for a Visitor Centre to be eligible for signing, it must meet the following criteria:

- The Visitor Centre will be open to the general public for recreational or cultural activities.
- The park will have staff members available to provide services to the general public, including the Visitor Centre.
- Meet the requirements of all required agencies (e.g. Ministry of Health) as well meeting all provincial operating requirements, municipal zoning, and other regulations.

Sign Design**Advance Signing**

The Advance sign should be installed approximately two kilometres in advance of the access, when practical.

The sign assembly will consist of:

- The information symbol on the left side of a sign panel.
- The distance to the nearest access road from the sign assembly, to the nearest kilometre.
- Hours of Operation tab (IS-35H) is optional.
- A Closed tab (IS-33B), if the park is not operational for a full 12-month period. Placement of the tab will be the responsibility of the park.

Access Signing

The Access sign should be installed approximately two hundred metres in advance of the access, when practical.

The sign assembly will consist of:

- The information symbol (IS-27).
- A directional arrow tab (IS-29A).

Cost

For information on cost see the Ministry's Road Side Management Manual (RSM) 1050-17, Provincial Park Sign Fund Allotment.

Sign Removal

Signs may be removed if, in the opinion of the MoH, the conditions of the policy are not being met.
