

Settlement Services Agencies

What are Settlement Services?

Settlement Services provides individuals with orientation and general information to meet their settlement needs and facilitate their integration into Saskatchewan.

What services are available?

Settlement Services agencies provide individuals with orientation to resources in the community, needs assessments, settlement planning and referrals to employment services and other supports.

Settlement Services agencies provide the following supports:

Settlement Information:

- Pre-arrival services virtually and by email to eligible participants.
- General information and referrals to settlement services and language training, public services, and resources in the community.
- Service groups and employers can access the program to obtain and provide information to immigrant employees and clients.

Settlement Advising Services:

- Individualized supports such as identifying where and how to access resources and services, this includes on-one-one supports to understand a participant's strengths and needs, assess options for addressing the specific settlement challenges the participant is facing.
- Assistance with developing and completing settlement action plans.
- Referrals to other services in the community, such as language or employment training, as required.
- There is no cost to participants for services.
- Settlement Services staff are not able to assist with immigration documents and processes.

Who is eligible?

Eligible pre-arrival participants are:

- Individuals 18 years of age or older; and,
- Must be an approved nominee of the Saskatchewan Immigrant Nominee Program.

Eligible participants for Settlement Information:

- Individuals 18 years of age or older, who do not have permanent resident status.

Eligible participants for Settlement Advising Services:

- Individuals 18 years of age or older, who do not have permanent resident status;
- Have been in Saskatchewan fewer than 5 years; and,
- Are eligible to work in Saskatchewan.
