

Routine Immunization Schedule

Vaccines help protect Saskatchewan residents from preventable diseases. Staying up to date with the recommended immunization schedule provides the best protection against serious diseases, and free vaccines are available through Public Health and participating health-care providers.

Childhood Schedule

AGE/GRADE	VACCINE ABBREVIATIONS AND NAMES
2 months	• DTaP-IPV-Hib (Diphtheria, Tetanus, acellular Pertussis, inactivated Polio & <i>Haemophilus influenza</i> type b) • Pneu-C-15 (Pneumococcal conjugate 15) • Rot-5 (Rotavirus)
4 months	• DTaP-IPV-Hib • Pneu-C-15 • Rot-5
6 months	• DTaP-IPV-Hib • Rot-5
12 months	• MMRV (Measles, Mumps, Rubella, Varicella) • Meningococcal conjugate ACYW-135 (Meningococcal conjugate ACYW-135) • Pneu-C-15 • Hepatitis A (for children living in a SK First Nations community, in the Athabasca Health Authority or a non-First Nations community in Northern SK excluding Creighton, Air Ronge and La Ronge)
18 months	• DTaP-IPV-Hib • MMRV • Hepatitis A
4-6 years	• Tdap-IPV (Tetanus, Diphtheria, acellular Pertussis, inactivated Polio)
Grade 6	• HB (Hepatitis B) • HPV-9 (Human papillomavirus – 9 strains)
Grade 8	• Tdap (Tetanus, Diphtheria, acellular Pertussis) • Meningococcal conjugate ACYW-135
6 months - 17 years	• COVID-19 (yearly) • Influenza (yearly)

Adult Schedule

18+ years	• COVID-19 (yearly) • Influenza (yearly) • Tdap (Tetanus, Diphtheria, acellular Pertussis) every 10 years and in every pregnancy
65+ years	• COVID-19 (yearly) • Influenza (yearly) • Pneu-C-21 (Pneumococcal conjugate 21) for adults who have not previously received a pneumococcal vaccine
