Jeff Markewich has more than 17 years' experience with the Government of Saskatchewan with the Ministries of Justice and Attorney General; Corrections, Public Safety and Policing; and Government Relations. Jeff has served on several boards and committees, including being the Government ex-officio board member for six Community Development Corporations pertaining to the Gaming Framework Agreement.

Jeff obtained his CPA-CMA in 2004 and holds a Bachelor of Administration degree from the University of Regina. During his career with the Government of Saskatchewan, he has contributed to various priority initiatives and projects including the creation of the Saskatchewan Public Safety Agency, providing pandemic support to First Nation and Métis organizations, and the review of the Gaming Framework Agreement.

In November 2022, Jeff became the Assistant Deputy Minister of Central Services and Standards for the Ministry of Government Relations. He oversees Corporate Services, Policy and Program Services and Building and Technical Standards. He is also the Safety Champion for the ministry.
