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SASKATCHEWAN REGULATIONS 85/2022*The Health Shared Services Saskatchewan (3sHealth) Act*

Section 8-1

Order in Council 526/2022, dated November 23, 2022

(Filed November 23, 2022)

Title

1 These regulations may be cited as *The Health Shared Services Saskatchewan (3sHealth) Regulations*.

Definition

2 In these regulations, “**Act**” means *The Health Shared Services Saskatchewan (3sHealth) Act*.

Prescribed amounts

3(1) The amount prescribed for the purposes of clause 2-6(1)(a) of the Act is \$1,000,000.

(2) The amount prescribed for the purposes of clause 2-6(1)(b) of the Act is \$1,000,000.

(3) The amount prescribed for the purposes of clause 2-6(1)(c) of the Act is \$1,000,000.

(4) The amount prescribed for the purposes of clause 2-6(1)(d) of the Act is \$1,000,000.

(5) The amount prescribed for the purposes of clause 2-6(1)(e) of the Act is \$1,000,000.

(6) The amount prescribed for the purposes of subsection 2-6(2) of the Act is \$1,000,000.

Board of directors

4(1) In this section, “**capacity**” means the ability:

- (a) to understand information relevant to making a decision; and
- (b) to appreciate the reasonably foreseeable consequences of making or not making a decision.

(2) To be eligible for appointment as a member of the board, a person must be:

- (a) a Canadian citizen; and
- (b) at least 18 years old.

(3) A person is disqualified from being a member of the board if the person:

- (a) lacks capacity;
- (b) is an undischarged bankrupt;
- (c) is an employee of the corporation;
- (d) holds office as a member of the Legislative Assembly, the House of Commons or the Senate of Canada;
- (e) is a judge of the Court of King’s Bench or Court of Appeal;

(f) has been convicted of an offence pursuant to section 123, 124 or 125 of the *Criminal Code* and has not received an absolute discharge or pardon with respect to the offence; or

(g) has been convicted of an offence that is punishable by imprisonment for 5 years or more and has not received an absolute discharge or pardon with respect to the offence.

Insurance

5(1) In this section, “**automobile insurance**” does not include the insurance evidenced by a certificate of insurance issued pursuant to *The Automobile Accident Insurance Act*.

(2) The corporation shall maintain insurance of the following types and amounts:

(a) insurance covering the full replacement cost of all buildings, equipment and furnishings against loss or damage by fire or other perils normally insured against under all-risk coverage;

(b) general liability insurance, in an amount not less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence, against liability arising from injury to or the death of persons and loss of or damage to property occurring in facilities owned or operated by the corporation;

(c) with respect to the motor vehicles owned or leased by the corporation, automobile insurance, in an amount not less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence, insuring the corporation and the operator against liability arising from:

(i) bodily injury to or the death of a person, including a person carried for compensation, or loss of or damage to property, caused by a motor vehicle or the use or operation of a motor vehicle; or

(ii) loss of or damage to a motor vehicle and the loss of use of a motor vehicle.

Auditor

6 For the purposes of section 6-4 of the Act, the auditor must:

(a) in the case of an individual, be a member in good standing of a recognized accounting profession that is regulated by an Act; or

(b) in the case of a firm, have at least one partner who is a member in good standing of a recognized accounting profession that is regulated by an Act.

Coming into force

7(1) Subject to subsection (2), these regulations come into force on the day on which section 1-1 of *The Health Shared Services Saskatchewan (3sHealth) Act* comes into force.

(2) If these regulations are filed with the Registrar of Regulations after the day on which section 1-1 of *The Health Shared Services Saskatchewan (3sHealth) Act* comes into force, these regulations come into force on the day on which they are filed with the Registrar of Regulations.

Title

1 These regulations may be cited as *The Wildlife Habitat and Ecological Lands Designation Amendment Regulations, 2022 (No. 3)*.

2 **The Appendix to *The Wildlife Habitat and Ecological Lands Designation Regulations* is amended:**

(a) by repealing item 50 and substituting the following:

“50 The north-west quarter of Section 11, in Township 11, in Range 32, west of the First Meridian”;

(b) by repealing item 250 and substituting the following:

“250 All those lands in Township 2, in Range 9, west of the Second Meridian, that are Crown owned and described as follows:

- (a) Section 11;
- (b) the north-west quarter of Section 25;
- (c) Section 26;
- (d) the north half of Section 27;
- (e) the north-east quarter of Section 28;
- (f) the east half and north-west quarter of Section 32;
- (g) Section 33;
- (h) Section 34;
- (i) the south half of Section 35”;

(c) by repealing item 284 and substituting the following:

“284 The south-east quarter and north-west quarter of Section 11 excluding the parcel on the north-east side of Pheasant Creek as shown on Plan 102370182 Ext 1 and the parcel on the south-west side of Pheasant Creek as shown on Plan 102370182 Ext 2, in Township 24, in Range 10, west of the Second Meridian”;

(d) by repealing item 495 and substituting the following:

“495 All those lands in Township 42, in Range 20, west of the Second Meridian, described as follows:

- (a) the south-east quarter of Section 1;
- (b) the east half and Legal Subdivisions 3, 4 and 6 of Section 11;
- (c) the east half of Section 12;
- (d) the south-east quarter of Section 13;

- (e) the north-east quarter of Section 22;
- (f) the south-west quarter of Section 27;
- (g) the south half of Section 28”;

(e) by repealing item 1049 and substituting the following:

“1049 All those lands in Township 25, in Range 13, west of the Third Meridian, described as follows:

- (a) the south-east quarter of Section 10;
- (b) the south-west quarter of Section 12”;

(f) by adding the following item after item 1074:

“1074.1 The north-west quarter of Section 10, in Township 3, in Range 14, west of the Third Meridian”;

(g) by repealing item 1121 and substituting the following:

“1121 All those lands in Township 41, in Range 15, west of the Third Meridian, described as follows:

- (a) the south-east quarter of Section 11;
- (b) the north-west quarter of Section 26;
- (c) the north-east quarter of Section 34”;

(h) by adding the following item after item 1273.1:

“1273.2 The portion of the south-west quarter of Section 16 lying to the west of Tramping Lake in Township 37, in Range 20, west of the Third Meridian”;

(i) by repealing item 1367 and substituting the following:

“1367 All those lands in Township 2, in Range 23, west of the Third Meridian, described as follows:

- (a) the south-east quarter of Section 3;
- (b) the north-west quarter of Section 5;
- (c) the south half of Section 6;
- (d) the west half of Section 8;
- (e) the south-west quarter of Section 10;
- (f) the south-west quarter of Section 17;
- (g) the north half and south-east quarter of Section 18;
- (h) the south-west quarter of Section 21”;

(j) by adding the following item after item 1464:

“1464.1 Section 13, in Township 25, in Range 25, west of the Third Meridian”; **and**

(k) by adding the following item after item 1544:

“1544.1 All those lands in Township 4, in Range 28, west of the Third Meridian, described as follows:

- (a) Section 11;
- (b) the south-west quarter of Section 12”.

Coming into force
