### About

IRIS Version 9.6 Release implemented 20 items. The mailing address for the Ministry of Energy and Resources has been updated in IRIS. An enhancement has been implemented that will auto-fill certain obligations upon approval of a *Segment Data Amendment Application*. Improvements have been made to the *Report Drilling Activity* screen and the *Facility Licence Expiration* process. A new permission has been added that permits licensees to subscribe to certain notifications. As well, various enhancements and fixes to known defects were implemented to various IRIS Modules.

### What's changed?

The highlights of what has changed in IRIS Version 9.6 release are noted below.

**Note:** Whether a user has access to the functionality or enhancements outlined in these *9.6 Release Notes* depends on the individual's security access and assigned permissions sets.

- The mailing address for the Ministry of Energy and Resources has been updated in IRIS. The new Mailing address is: 610 - 1945 Hamilton Street, REGINA SK S4P 2C7.

### Infrastructure Functionality

- An enhancement has been implemented where IRIS will auto-fulfill the following obligations upon approval of a *Segment Data Amendment Application* submitted for the obligation:
  - *Report Segment Watercourse Crossing*
  - *Construction Completion Report Spatial Data*
  - *Construction Completion Report Pipe Segment Data*
  - *Outside Right of Way*
- An enhancement has been made to the *Report Drilling Activity* screen. Industry users are now able to add additional wellbores via response to a new disclosure question in the *Edit Drilling*

*Activity popup.* The question states *Were any additional wellbores drilled that were not licenced and will contribute to the production of the well (ie. not a ghosthole)?* Answering *Yes* to this question allows users access to the *Add a Wellbore* feature. This improvement will eliminate the wait time that Industry currently experiences while Ministry adds the wellbore for Industry to complete their reporting.

- An enhancement has been made to the *Facility Licence Expiration* process. Upon implementation, if a Facility Licence's *Report Construction Complete* obligation is not fulfilled within the specified 2-year period, IRIS automatically cancels the licence. In addition, a new permission set was created that permits licensees to subscribe to *Facility Licences Expiry Warning Notifications (First Notification for Facility Licence Expiring and Second Notification for Facility Licence Expiring)* and *Facility Licence Cancelled Notification*.
