February 13, 2023	Update on Directive PNG008	BT2023-003

Directive PNG008: Disposal and Injection Well Requirements (Directive PNG008) sets out the requirements of the Saskatchewan Ministry of Energy and Resources (ER) for the licensing and operation of disposal and injection wells, which can be found at [Directive PNG008](#). ER wishes to draw attention to the third paragraph of section 1 of Directive PNG008, which states that disposal and injection wells approved prior to the effective date of Directive PNG008 (March 29, 2018) must meet the directive's completion, operation, monitoring and logging requirements within five years of that effective date, which is March 29, 2023 unless otherwise approved by ER.

Further to the above, this bulletin is to advise that ER is indefinitely suspending the March 29, 2023 deadline for disposal and injection wells approved prior to March 29, 2018 to be in compliance with Directive PNG008 and its requirements. Please note that ER also plans to engage with industry stakeholders on Directive PNG008 and seek feedback on potential changes to the directive.
