## **Overview of Travel and Objectives**

---

The purpose of this travel was for Premier Moe to attend the Winter 2023 Council of the Federation Meeting (COF) and to attend the Working Meeting of First Ministers on Health Care.

Established in 2003, COF comprises the thirteen Premiers of Canada's Provinces and Territories (PTs). It is a forum for managing PT relations with the federal government, reinforcing the work of sectoral forums, and providing leadership on issues of importance to Canadians.

The COF meeting was an opportunity for Premiers to discuss priorities and ascertain alignment ahead of the Working Meeting of First Ministers' where it was anticipated that the Prime Minister would table a new funding proposal for health care.

The Working Meeting of First Ministers on Health Care was the first time the federal government sat down with Premiers over the past two years to discuss the sustainability of provincial and territorial health care systems. The federal government tabled a proposal for new health funding.

Saskatchewan's primary objective going into both meetings were to ensure that the needs of Saskatchewan's health care system was recognized and addressed through additional funding from the federal government.

### **Travel Activity**

Premier Moe attended the COF Winter Meeting and Working Meeting of First Ministers on Health Care in Ottawa on February 5-8, 2022. Canada's Premiers discussed a number of topics, including health care funding, health system priorities, health human resources, and health data system improvements. First Ministers' discussions focused on health care funding and common priorities for health system improvements.

The COF meeting included a closing press conference and various sessions of media availability. Premier Moe also participated in media interviews with major national news outlets.
