About

IRIS Version 9.12 Release implemented 25 items. In addition to the changes detailed below, various enhancements and fixes to known defects were implemented to various IRIS Modules.

What's changed?

The highlights of what has changed in IRIS Version 9.12 release are noted below.

Note: Whether a user has access to the functionality or enhancements outlined in these *9.12 Release Notes* depends on the individual's security access and assigned permissions sets.

Infrastructure Functionality

- In the Pipeline module, a new disclosure question has been created for the Licence Data Amendment and Segment Data Amendment applications, when the application is being submitted for a retroactively licenced pipeline/flowline. Disclosure question P30 will be replaced with P30a in these situations, and the question itself will remain the same, stating *"Has the proposed segment(s) been designed to meet the pressure limits of the system, including downstream components?"* A response of 'Unknown' has been added to allow industry to provide the most accurate information to the Ministry within the application.
- In the Pipeline module, when a user clicks any Segment ID hyperlink the resulting 'Segment Summary' pop-up screen will include a tab labeled as '**Spec Changes**'. The new '**Spec Changes**' tab will display the available Segment Spec Change Data, as derived from the *Segment Details* 'Spec Changes' tab.

In the instance where no data is available from the *Segment Details* 'Spec Changes' tab, the system will display the text **"There are no Spec Changes for this segment."** On the '**Spec Changes**' tab available through the 'Segment Summary' pop-up screen.

Additional permission sets are not required to see this information.

- In the Pipeline module, a defect has been corrected where attached documents were deleted unknowingly upon reporting a Pressure Test on a pipeline segment. All impacted documents have been reinstated.
- In the Pipeline module, IRIS will now generate a popup warning message on *Pipeline Segment Splitting Applications* to remind users to preview the entries again (using the MapViewer) when the applicant clicks Submit. The applicant will either click “Cancel” to go back and verify or “Proceed Anyway” to continue with the submission.
- The Ministry of Energy and Resources Facility Team has reviewed all Facility Site locations and where possible, re-spatialized (moved) the Facility Site location to where the majority of a facility’s infrastructure exists. This was accomplished by reviewing approximately 7700 facility sites using ArcPro. Re-spatialization was accomplished by reviewing several years of ortho (photo) images using a best estimate to determine the new location. For any identified Facility Site, the Latitude and Longitude coordinates have been updated accordingly on IRIS.
- This IRIS release includes the implementation of two major initiatives.

The Construction Completion Report Changes initiative will allow the Ministry to withdraw Pipeline and Flowline Construction Completion Reports when reported in error. Construction Completion Reports for these licences and authorizations can be submitted again if appropriate, or the authorizations canceled if necessary.

The Mineral Trust Rental Payment initiative will introduce new Mineral Trust Rental Payment functionality that will automate the rental and bonus bid amounts owed and provide monthly payments to the eligible Trust Payees.
