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Foreword

Saskatchewan's pediatric surgery diagnosis code list is based on **Pediatric Canadian Access Targets for Surgery (PCATS)**. Slight adjustments have been made to align the format with adult surgical diagnosis codes, and Saskatchewan 6-digit diagnosis codes are used in place of PCATS 4-digit codes. PCATS also includes a wait time target for 24 hours. However, diagnoses that have a 24 hour wait time target are not included in Saskatchewan's surgical diagnosis code list. At this time emergency surgeries are not booked using the provincial surgical booking form, and a diagnosis code is not required.

PCATS was created in 2008 as part of the Canadian Paediatric Surgical Wait Times Project, funded by Health Canada — Health Care Policy Contributions Program (2007 to 2011). It was developed by over 100 pediatric surgeons and surgical subspecialties across Canada. It represents the standard of care for performing surgery on children, based on evidence and expert consensus.

In the absence of continuing oversight for PCATS, Saskatchewan pediatric surgeons (with approval of the Surgical Registry Physician Advisory Committee) updated several priorities in 2026-27 to better align with current evidence and best practice. Any variations from PCATS are noted.
