#### About

On March 13, 2024, Saskatchewan’s Ministry of Energy and Resources (ER) implemented the Fluid Analysis Data Management (FADM) project into the Integrated Resource Information System (IRIS).

The FADM project brings functionality into IRIS that will expand the parameters of fluid analysis data collected in the interest of providing more complete and accurate information regarding analysis results. Additional functionality will allow industry to submit and consume fluid analysis data in bulk format within IRIS. To make the best use of the enhancement, the type of data will include that collected from oil, gas, and water analysis.

#### What’s changed?

The highlights of what’s changed in IRIS as a result of this release are noted below.

**Note:** Whether a user has access to the functionality or enhancements outlined in these 9.12.5 Release Notes will depend on the individual’s security access and assigned permissions sets.

#### Fluid Analysis Data Submission

- Expanded the parameters of data collected on-screen. The expanded parameters will allow for the capture of more complete oil, gas, and water analysis data, and more accurate analysis results.
- Fluid analysis data can be batch uploaded, through the application process, to IRIS in XML format. This function will require the use of templates available at [IRIS Submission Forms](#).

## Fluid Analysis Data Consumption

- IRIS users will be able to download the new ***Fluid Analysis Submission Detail Report*** from the Reports section of IRIS. The report downloads in CSV format, consists of non-confidential fluid analysis data, and has some functionality to filter results before download.
