

Excluded Business Types and Occupations: SINP Job Offer Categories

The following business types are **not eligible** to obtain an Employer Position Assessment (EPA) through the Saskatchewan Immigrant Nominee Program (SINP).

- Places of worship or religious organizations.
- Licensed recruiter or immigration consultant's business.
- Spas, salons, and nail salons.
- Pet care services (excluding veterinarians).
- Massage service operations (excluding Licensed Registered Massage Therapists as described below).

The following occupations are **not eligible** for the SINP sub-categories requiring a job offer and EPA from a Saskatchewan employer unless certain requirements, listed below, are met.

NOC	Occupation Title and Restriction
10022	Advertising, marketing, and public relations managers unless the candidate is currently working in Saskatchewan under a valid Labour Market Impact Assessment (LMIA) or Canada-Ukraine Authorization for Emergency Travel (CUAET) work permit.
11202	Professional occupations in advertising, marketing, and public relations unless the candidate is currently working in Saskatchewan under a valid LMIA or CUAET work permit.
12200	Accounting technicians and bookkeepers unless the candidate is: • Working in Saskatchewan on a valid work permit based on a positive LMIA, CUAET work permit or Francophone Mobility work permit; or • Have completed an accounting program from a Saskatchewan Designated Learning Institution; or • Are working for an employer in the professional, scientific and technical services sector (North American Industry Classification System sector code 54 and its subsectors).
32200	Chinese health practitioners/Acupuncturist unless the candidate is currently in Saskatchewan under a valid LMIA or CUAET work permit.
32201	Massage therapist, including those within massage service operations, unless the candidate is a Licensed Registered Massage Therapists (RMT) who is currently in Saskatchewan under a valid LMIA or CUAET work permit.

NOC	Occupation Title and Restriction
32209	Other practitioners of natural healing unless the candidate is currently in Saskatchewan under a valid LMIA or CUAET work permit.
33109	Other assisting occupations in support of health services is no longer eligible for positions that support Chinese Health Practitioner, Acupuncturist or Naturopath.
41302	Religious leaders
41402	Business development officers and market researchers, analysts unless the candidate is currently working in Saskatchewan under a valid LMIA or CUAET work permit.
42204	Religious workers
43200	Sheriffs and bailiffs unless the candidate is currently working in Saskatchewan under a valid LMIA or CUAET work permit.
43202	By-law enforcement and other regulatory officers unless the candidate is currently working in Saskatchewan under a valid LMIA or CUAET work permit.
