Step 1: Creating the Colouring Page

Colouring pages are created at factories! Factories use trees to make paper. Recycling Heroes know that every new sheet of paper starts with materials that can be recycled later!



Step 2: Using the Colouring Page

Once you have your colouring page, it's time to get creative with crayons, markers or pencils! Recycling Heroes take good care of their things to make them last longer.



Step 3: Repairing the Colouring Page

Oops! Your paper got a tear. That's okay – Recycling Heroes know how to repair it with some tape or glue, so it can be used again and again.



Step 4: Reusing the Colouring Page

After you've finished colouring, don't toss your drawing into a blue bin just yet. Upcycle Artist suggests reusing the back of the page for another drawing or a fun art project!



Step 5: Recycling the Colouring Page

When the colouring page can't be used any more, be like Recycle Ranger and Captain Compost. Make sure it finds its way to a recycling or compost bin to be turned into something new.



Step 6: New Life for the Colouring Page
