Overview of Travel and Objectives

The purpose of this travel was for Premier Scott Moe to attend the 2024 Fall Meeting of the Council of the Federation (COF).

Established in 2003, COF comprises the 13 Premiers of Canada's Provinces and Territories (PTs). It is a forum for managing PT relations with the federal government, reinforcing the work of sectoral forums, and providing leadership on issues of importance to Canadians.

The meeting was held in Toronto, Ontario, and presented an opportunity to discuss energy security, health care, and the importance of all governments working together to ensure a 'Team Canada' approach to Canada-United States (US) relations.

Saskatchewan's primary objective during the meeting was to support a collaborative approach to Canada-US relations through COF and working with the federal government. Saskatchewan also emphasized the importance of the federal government collaborating with PTs to ensure all regions are treated equally when finding solutions to the incoming US administration's proposed tariffs.

Travel Activity

Premier Moe attended the COF Fall Meeting in Toronto, Ontario, on December 16, 2024. Canada's Premiers discussed several topics related to Federal-Provincial-Territorial relations, including Canada-US relations, energy security, and health care.

Outcomes included one joint communiqué calling for federal partnership and action and focused on three priority areas:

- 1) Canada-US relations
- 2) Energy security
- 3) Health care

Premiers reiterated their commitment to these priorities within the federation and made specific calls on the federal government.
