Overview of Travel and Objectives

The purpose of this travel was for Premier Scott Moe to attend a Working Meeting of First Ministers on Canada-United States (US) relations.

The meeting was held in Ottawa, Ontario, and presented an opportunity to discuss a 'Team Canada' approach to working with the US and to discuss a potential response to the Trump Administration's threat of 25% import tariffs.

Saskatchewan's primary objective during the meeting was to support a collaborative approach to Canada-US relations through the Council of the Federation and when working with the federal government. Saskatchewan also emphasized the importance of ensuring that any measures taken by Canada in response to US tariffs consider the impact on different sectors and regions.

Travel Activity

Premier Moe attended the Working Meeting of First Ministers on January 15, 2025. First Ministers discussed Canada-US relations and the threat of 25% tariffs by the US.

Outcomes included a joint statement that underscored the harm tariffs will pose to the North American economy, outlined efforts to bolster security at the border, highlighted the need to support impacted businesses if tariffs are enacted, and committed to working in partnership to advance Canadian interests.

First Ministers affirmed their intentions to take a 'Team Canada' approach when engaging with the US.
