

## **NOTICE TO BUSINESSES IMPACTED BY WILDFIRES**

### **RELIEF FOR LATE FILING AND PAYMENT**

Businesses directly impacted by wildfire activity in the province (including evacuation, temporary closure, or service disruption) that, as a result, are unable to file and/or pay their provincial tax return(s) by the due date may apply for relief from penalty and interest.

Submit a [Penalty and Interest Waiver Application](#) including:

- Details of the wildfire-related circumstances that prevented the timely filing and/or payment, and
- The location of the affected business

### **FILING AND PAYMENT OPTIONS**

The easiest and quickest way to file and pay your provincial tax return(s) is electronically.

File your return:

- Saskatchewan eTax Services (SETS) at [sets.saskatchewan.ca](https://sets.saskatchewan.ca), or
- Online business services offered by financial institutions (e.g., Telpay or CanAct).

Electronic payment(s) can be made through:

- SETS (Electronic Funds Transfer),
- Personal or business online banking services, or
- Wire transfer.

### **REFUNDS AND PAYMENTS**

If you are expecting a refund or payment and are not set up with direct deposit, please contact our office at 1-800-667-6102 to:

- Enroll indirect deposit, or
- Provide an alternate mailing address if you have relocated.

Refunds can also be sent by courier at the recipient's expense.

## **POSTAL SERVICE DISRUPTION DUE TO WILDFIRES**

In the event of a postal disruption:

- Businesses should use electronic filing and payment options where possible.
- Returns and correspondence may be submitted by courier, at your own expense, to 4th floor, 2350 Albert Street in Regina, Saskatchewan.

If you have relocated, please call 1-800-667-6102 and update your mailing address.

## **RECORD KEEPING**

Businesses should retain documentation supporting any wildfire-related disruptions affecting their ability to comply with tax obligations.
