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Introduction

On Thursday, September 19, 2024, at approximately 2:00 p.m., the Saskatchewan Serious Incident Response Team (SIRT) received a notification from the Saskatoon Police Service (SPS) regarding an off-duty incident involving several members of SPS. SIRT's Civilian Executive Director accepted the notification as within SIRT's mandate and directed an investigation to be conducted by SIRT.

Timeline

SIRT was notified of the incident on September 19, 2024, at approximately 2:00 p.m., and a team of SIRT Investigators was assigned to begin the investigation. On January 21, 2025, the completed investigation was provided to SIRT's Civilian Executive Director for review, and on February 20, 2025, pursuant to S. 91.08(10) of *The Police Act, 1990*, the matter was provided to the office of the Attorney General for Saskatchewan. On October 20, 2025, SIRT received correspondence from the office of the Attorney General for Saskatchewan, and on October 30, 2025, the Subject Officer was arrested by SIRT Investigators.

The Investigation

SIRT's investigation was comprehensive and thorough, conducted using current investigative protocols, and in accordance with the principles of Major Case Management (MCM). During the course of the investigation, all relevant witnesses were interviewed, and all available audio, video, and documentary evidence was seized.

During the course of SIRT's investigation, one member of SPS was designated as a Subject Officer, and 23 members of SPS were designated as Witness Officers. In addition to the members involved, nine civilian witnesses were identified and interviewed during the course of the investigation.

As these matters are now before the court, certain details have been omitted from this report pursuant to S.7.6(2) of *The Police Regulations*, 95/2022 s5.

Summary

On September 19, 2024, SIRT commenced an investigation into an allegation of assault, alleged to have taken place off-duty at a social gathering on September 14, 2024. One member of SPS was designated as the Subject Officer in SIRT's investigation. Following a comprehensive review of the evidence gathered during the course of SIRT's investigation, it was determined that reasonable grounds existed to believe that an offence had been committed by the Subject Officer. On October 30, 2025, the Subject Officer was arrested by SIRT Investigators and charged with:

- 1) Assault contrary to S.266 of the *Criminal Code of Canada*.

Following the arrest, the Subject Officer was released on an Undertaking, and will appear in Saskatoon Provincial Court on Thursday, November 27, 2025 at 2:00 p.m. As these matters remain before the courts, and pursuant to the requirements of S.7.6(2) of *The Police Regulations*, 95/2022 s5, no additional information can be provided in relation to this matter.

Decision

Pursuant to S.91.08(10)(a) of *The Police Act, 1990*, this matter has been referred to the Attorney General for Saskatchewan.
