

Final Clinical Placement (FCP) Bursary

The Ministry of Health's Final Clinical Placement (FCP) Bursary is offered to students in an eligible health discipline that requires the completion of a **final clinical placement**.

FUNDING



\$2,000 one-time payment

- **Return in Service Commitment**

- Applicants must commit to a one-year return in service (RIS) in an approved publicly funded position in rural or northern Saskatchewan.
- Any community that is outside the cities of Regina or Saskatoon is considered rural for the purpose of this bursary.

Exceptions to completing an RIS in rural or northern Saskatchewan include professions such as Magnetic Resonance Imaging (MRI) Technologists, Nuclear Medicine, or other occupations where employment is limited to the cities of Regina or Saskatoon.

ELIGIBILITY



Any Saskatchewan resident completing an unpaid FCP in Saskatchewan in a position that qualifies as a high priority classification is eligible to apply.

Restrictions could include individuals who may be in receipt of another bursary where an RIS commitment is required.

APPLYING



Applications are accepted twice per year:

- Spring FCP begins between April 1 and September 30
- Fall FCP begins between October 1 and March 1

- A letter from the Clinical Placement Coordinator confirming applicant's acceptance into a final clinical placement program, including dates and location of the final clinical placement.
