Ahead of the Federal-Provincial-Territorial Conference of Ministers and Deputy Ministers of Agriculture, participants took the opportunity to meet with Cereals Canada and tour their facility on September 7, 2025, in Winnipeg, Manitoba.

The purpose of the travel was to represent Saskatchewan at the annual Federal-Provincial-Territorial Conference of Ministers and Deputy Ministers of Agriculture. The meeting is an opportunity for Ministers, Deputies, and other officials to meet in-person and discuss mutual priorities and concerns that contribute to strengthening the Canadian agriculture and agri-food industry and positioning our sector for success. Topics included trade and market access, Business Risk Management, and the pesticide regulatory process.
