MINISTER'S ORDER

No: 6 and 46-2023-WI

ORDER for Increasing Weight Designation on Provincial Highways Inland Drive (6-06-40) and Range Road 2193 (46-01-40).

Reference: Increasing weight limits to 63,500 kg for B-Trains configurations on the portion of Provincial Highways Inland Drive and Range Road 2193.

Pursuant to section 35.1 of *The Highways and Transportation Act, 1997*, the Minister hereby Orders:

For the purpose of managing traffic on and protecting provincial highways, NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that effective 12:01 AM, January 11, 2023, unless restricted by a Minister's Order issued pursuant to *The Highways and Transportation Act, 1997*, this Order allows the maximum gross vehicle weight allowance for a B Train to 63,500 kg as set out in Section 18(4) of *The Vehicle Weight and Dimension Regulations, 2010*, on the following Provincial Highways:

- the portion of Inland Drive from the intersection of Provincial Highway 6 east to the intersection with Range Road 2193;
- the portion of Range Road 2193 from the intersection of Inland Drive south 800 metres to the corporate limits of the City of Regina.

This Order will remain in effect until rescinded.
