MINISTER'S ORDER **No: 44-2021-WI3**

ORDER for Increasing the Weight Designation on Provincial Highway No. 44

Reference: Increasing weight limits on Provincial Highway No. 44 from the junction with Provincial Highway No. 219 west to the municipal road located south of the SW Section 7, Township 27, Range 6, west of the 3rd Meridian.

Pursuant to section 35.1 of *The Highways and Transportation Act, 1997*, the Minister Hereby Orders:

For the purpose of managing traffic on and protecting provincial highways, NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that effective 12:01 AM, December 3, 2021 unless restricted by a Minister's Order issued pursuant to *The Highways and Transportation Act, 1997*, this Order authorizes any person, vehicle or class of vehicles to operate at the weights set for primary highways by *The Vehicle Weight and Dimension Regulations, 2010*, on Provincial Highway No. 44 from the junction with Provincial Highway No. 219 west to the municipal road located south of the SW Section 7, Township 27, Range 6, west of the 3rd Meridian.

Appendix D clause (kk) of *The Vehicle Weight and Dimension Regulations, 2010* (The 15 Kilometer Rule) does not apply to this Highway.

This Order is issued on a permanent basis and will not be affected by Spring Road Restriction Orders.
