About

IRIS Version 9.26 Release implemented 16 items. In addition to the changes detailed below, various enhancements and fixes to known defects were implemented to various IRIS Modules.

What’s changed?

The highlights of what has changed in IRIS Version 9.26 release are noted below.

Note: Whether a user has access to the functionality, or enhancements outlined in these *9.26 Release Notes* will depend on the individual’s security access and assigned permissions sets.

Infrastructure Functionality

- The existing menu options of “Administration” and “Support” have been removed from the IRIS landing page, which can be located by selecting the Government of Saskatchewan logo in the top left-hand corner. All reports that were available under the existing menu option of “Administration” will remain under the *Security Reports* menu header, and all reports that fell under “Support” will remain under the *Reports > Support* menu of the IRIS grey screen.
- The eligible pipeline segments are now displayed under *Impacted Segments* when reporting a field work notification through the *Field Work Notification* tab on the segments, and the *Field Work Notification* on the *Related Actions* side bar on the segment.
- Effective June 3, 2026, Ministry of Environment (MoE) obligations for *Well Licence* and *Facility Licence* applications are updated to align with the recent MoE permit conditions revision. All wells/facilities licensed prior to this date with MoE obligations will retain the retired obligations, and wells/facilities licensed after will have the updated obligations.
- Brand new *Review of Obligation* application will be replacing the existing waiver applications for *Directional Survey*, *Gas Well Test*, *Waive 30-day Absolute Open Flow (AOF) Test*, *Application*

for Addition, Deletion, Extension and Waiver. It will now encompass requests for Extension/Waive/Cancel/Delete of obligations as well as Waiver of Penalty. It will remain under the existing menu option of Applications – Waiver – Review of Obligation.
