

# Rural Civic Addressing

The Civic Address Registry (CAR) is a voluntary program in Saskatchewan that helps communities manage their address information and identify property locations for emergency response.

In rural communities, blue CAR signage must be kept in good condition and clearly visible from the public road. It's recommended that residents provide both their rural address and legal land description when making a 911 call.

**REMINDER:** Display your entire address inside your home where it's easily accessible and visible for quick reference.



**382:** The Township Road number to the south of the property.

**68:** The property's driveway access lot number, based on its location along the public road within the section.

**3064:** The Range Road number that the property's driveway accesses.



**3081:** The Range Road number to the east of the property.

**43:** The property's driveway access lot number, based on its location along the public road within the section.

**374:** The Township Road number that the property's driveway accesses.



**370:** The property's driveway access lot number is based on its location along the length of the named public road.

**HAULTAIN RD:** The name of the public road that the property's driveway accesses.



**24025:** The property's driveway access lot number is based on its location along the numbered provincial highway within the province.

**11:** The provincial highway number that the property's driveway accesses.  
*\*\*Grid Road addresses follow the same lot numbering principle.*
