1.	GENERAL INFORMATION (See <u>Out-of-Hours Premiums</u> in the Physician Payment Schedule)																																																										
a)	Out-of-Hours or Time of Day (TOD) premiums are special location indicators that provide compensation for physicians who are providing services outside of regular office hours.																																																										
b)	In order to generate the TOD premiums, you must enter the appropriate location indicator in your billing software (see chart below).																																																										
c)	Medical Services Branch’s payment system will then generate the appropriate payment electronically based on the eligible services.																																																										
d)	There are several services that TOD premiums are NOT eligible for such as hospital care codes (25-28B-T).
