While in Ottawa, Premier Moe met with foreign representatives of government and industry leaders.

- Excellency Wang Di, Ambassador of the People's Republic of China to Canada to discuss China's strategic priorities within the framework of the newly announced Canada-China strategic partnership and explore opportunities to deepen SK-China engagement, particularly in trade, agriculture, energy and innovation.
