Overview of Travel and Objectives

Travel to Ottawa alongside representatives from seven Saskatchewan cities and leaders from the Saskatchewan Association of Rural Municipalities (SARM) and the Saskatchewan Urban Municipalities Association (SUMA).

The delegation met with federal leaders to advocate for the restoration of cost-shared infrastructure investment programs, following the full subscription of the Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program (ICIP).

Discussions focused on the urgent need for new federal-provincial infrastructure funding, particularly for water and wastewater projects, to support housing development and accommodate Saskatchewan's continued population growth.

Travel Activity

- Meeting with Saskatchewan Conservative Members of Parliament.
- Meeting with Canada Mortgage and Housing Corporation (CMHC) officials.
- Meeting with the Secretary of State for Rural Development and Member of Parliament for Battlefords–Lloydminster.
- Networking event with Saskatchewan delegation members, including SUMA and SARM representatives.
- Meeting with the Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister of Housing, Infrastructure and Communities.
- Additional meetings with federal housing and infrastructure officials.
- Advanced Saskatchewan's position on the need for renewed federal-provincial cost-shared infrastructure investment programs following the full subscription of ICIP.
- Highlighted the critical role of water and wastewater infrastructure in supporting housing development and accommodating population growth.
- Strengthened relationships with federal officials, municipal leaders, and sector partners.
- Supported Saskatchewan's priorities related to infrastructure investment, housing supply, and sustainable community growth, while reinforcing intergovernmental and municipal partnerships.
