The **Canada-Saskatchewan Workforce Tariff Response** is a three-year, \$15.6 million initiative supporting workers and employers in tariff impacted sectors. Funding will build a strong, confident workforce where workers can navigate uncertainty and industries can remain competitive in the global marketplace.

Who Can Access Support

Eligible employers in tariff impacted sectors:

- steel
- softwood lumber
- manufacturing
- construction
- agriculture
- mining
- transportation and warehousing
- wholesale trade

Eligible workers in tariff impacted sectors including:

- unemployed workers on employment insurance (EI);
- workers whose employers are participating in EI work-sharing agreements; or
- employed workers at risk of job loss due to tariffs.
