Please follow these care guidelines after immunization:

- Encourage your child to use their arm as usual.
- Common side effects may include redness, pain, or tenderness at the injection site, mild fever, or feeling tired. These are usually mild and last 1 – 2 days.
- For redness or swelling, apply a cold compress to the area.
- Treat fever only if your child is uncomfortable, not drinking fluids, or not sleeping well (wait at least 6-8 hours after immunization).

Please report any unexpected or serious side effects to a public health nurse, your healthcare provider, or by calling HealthLine 811.

Use **Acetaminophen** (Tylenol®, Tempra®) or **Ibuprofen** (Advil®, Motrin®) to treat fevers and pain in children and adults. **Never give ASA** (Aspirin®) to anyone younger than 18 years old because of the serious risk of Reye's syndrome.

Accessing Immunization Records in MySaskHealthRecord

Immunization records **for Saskatchewan residents** are available in the **MySaskHealthRecord** online platform.

1. **For children 13 years old and younger, a parent or guardian must create a MySaskHealthRecord account for their child using the hyperlink above.**
 - a. Parents and guardians must have their own MySaskHealthRecord account to access their child's information.
 - b. Once set up, the child's account will be linked to the parent/guardian's account.
2. **Children 14 years and older must create their own MySaskHealthRecord account using the hyperlink above. Parents and guardians cannot access these accounts.**

If you do not wish to use the MySaskHealthRecord platform, contact your local public health office to request an emailed or printed copy of the student's immunization record. *Please note that a service fee may apply for this request.*
