1 Prior Learning Credit - Adult 12 Program

The prior learning credit is intended to acknowledge those adults returning to pursue an Adult 12 who bring sufficient learning experience to be recognized for a high school elective level 30 credit. A maximum of one prior learning credit may be used as part of the seven credits required for completion of an Adult 12. Adults obtaining credit for Prior Learning 30L must ensure that they obtain the appropriate admissions requirements for the post-secondary program of their choice since some programs require more than seven academic courses.

Notes:

- A prior learning credit is intended for adult learners and may be used only for completion under the Adult 12 policy.
- In most cases locally developed (designated with an L) courses may be used to meet elective requirements only.

1.1 Guidelines

1. To earn a prior learning credit, the student must be an adult and enrolled in the Adult 12 program. An adult is defined in Part VII, Section 30(1) of the Regulations under [The Education Act, 1995](#) means a person who is at least 18 years of age and who has been out of school for at least one year.
2. The adult student is responsible for contacting a Saskatchewan Polytechnic campus or a Regional College for the administration of a Prior Learning 30 Application for Credit.

1.2 Implementation

1. Adult learners are responsible for submitting documented evidence for consideration of a Prior Learning 30 credit to a Saskatchewan Polytechnic campus or a Regional College, using their Prior Learning 30 – Application for Credit form.

Note, this is not for use by a school division, the Conseil des écoles francsaskoises, the Saskatchewan Distance Learning Corporation, Independent schools or First Nations schools.

2. The Prior Learning 30 – Application for Credit form will be verified and recommended by the post-secondary institution official responsible for Adult 12. The post-secondary institution will forward the completed Prior Learning 30 – Application for Credit form to:

3. The Office of the Registrar, Student and Educator Services will verify eligibility, and award a Prior Learning 30 credit as recommended by the post-secondary institution towards completion of the Adult 12 program.
