

Affidavit C
Public Highway or Transmission Line

Sections 122(1)(f), 122(4) and 123(2) of The Planning and Development Act, 2007

- This Affidavit may be used in lieu of a Certificate of Approval for a plan of survey when dealing with a public highway or transmission line right-of-way, **IF** the right-of-way is over five kilometres from the limits of a city or 2.5 kilometres from the limits of a hamlet, organized hamlet, resort village, village or town.
- A completed affidavit must be submitted to the Information Services Corporation (ISC) when applying for approval of a plan of survey from the Controller of Surveys, except in the case of Rural Roads where The Department of Highways and Transportation would receive the said affidavit.
- An affidavit does not eliminate the need to obtain other permits from a municipality or government authorities.
- In the case where a plan widens the right of way of an existing public highway in accordance with Section 122(1)(g) no affidavit is required.
