

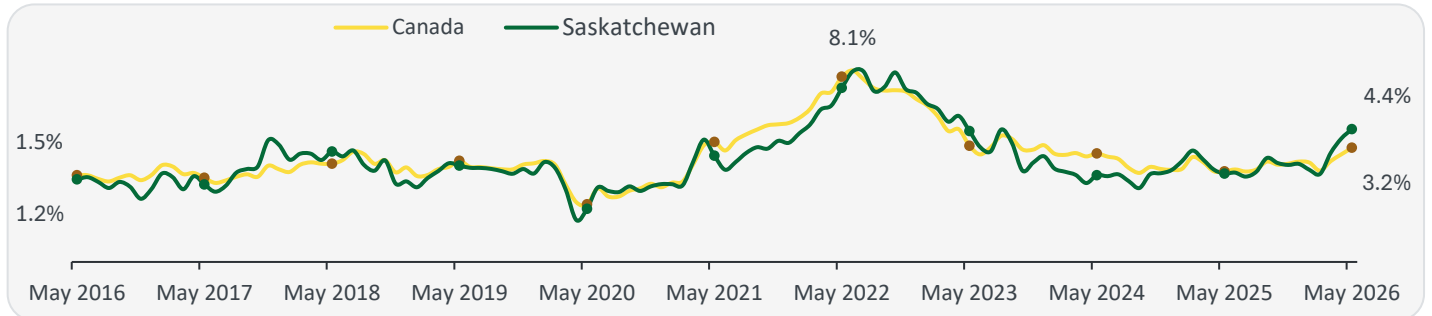

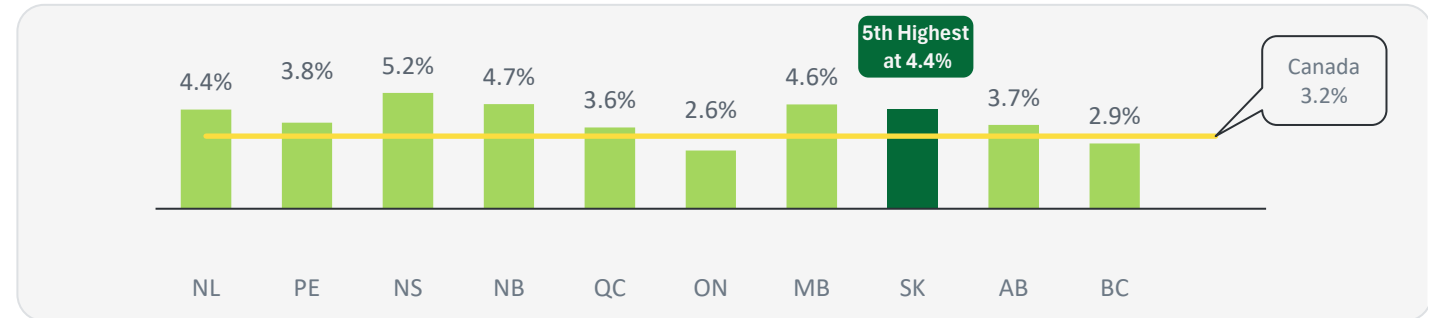
ANNUAL INFLATION RATE (YEAR-OVER-YEAR)

Canada's annual inflation rate was 3.2%	In Saskatoon, the annual inflation rate was 4.2%

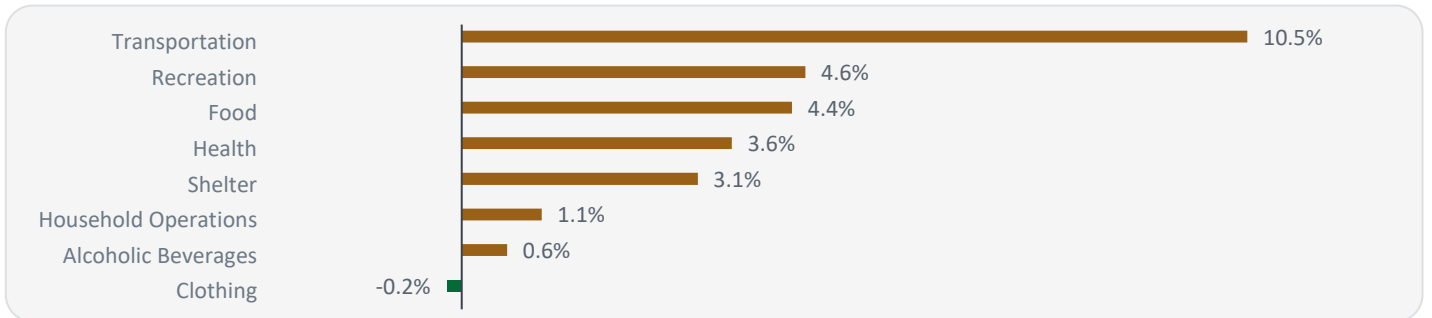
Graph 1: Annual Inflation Rates: Canada vs. Saskatchewan (May 2016 – May 2026)
