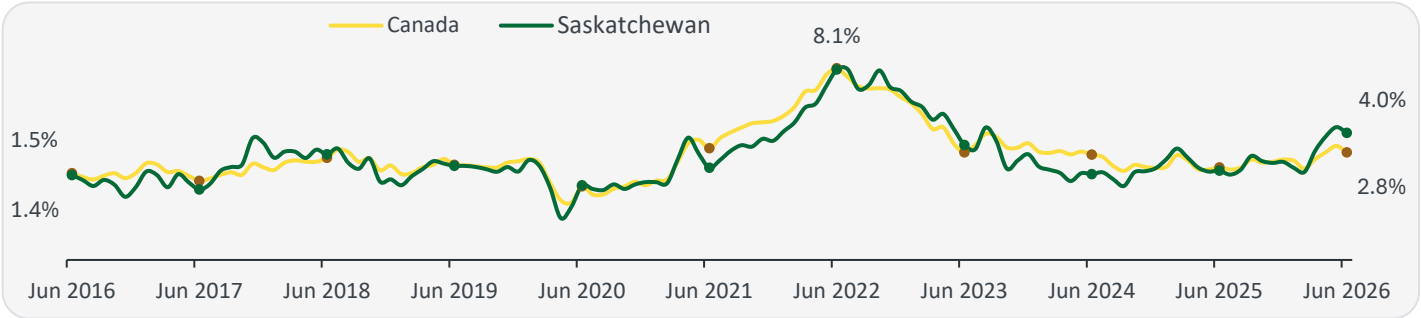

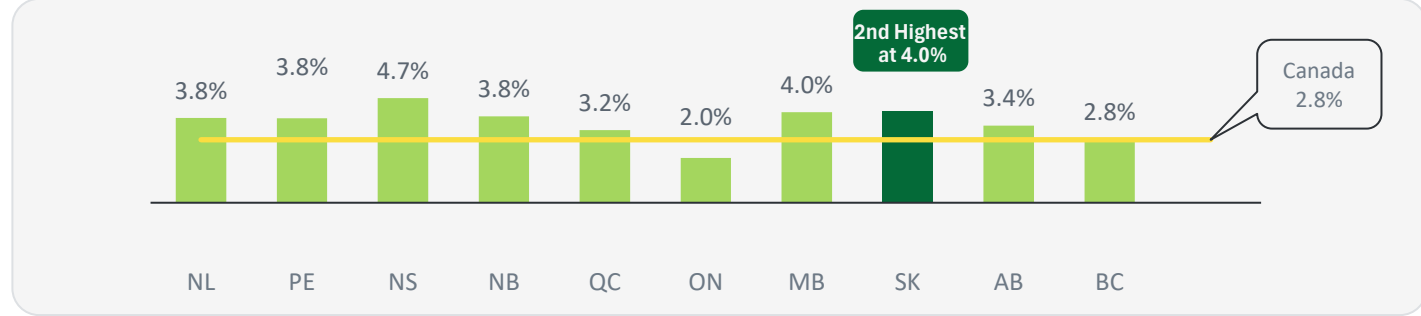

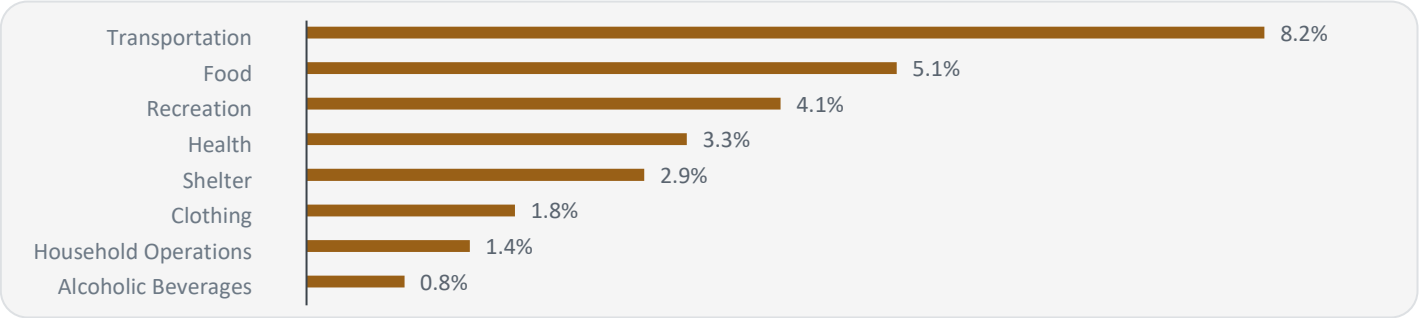
Graph 1: Annual Inflation Rates: Canada vs. Saskatchewan (Jun 2016 – Jun 2026)

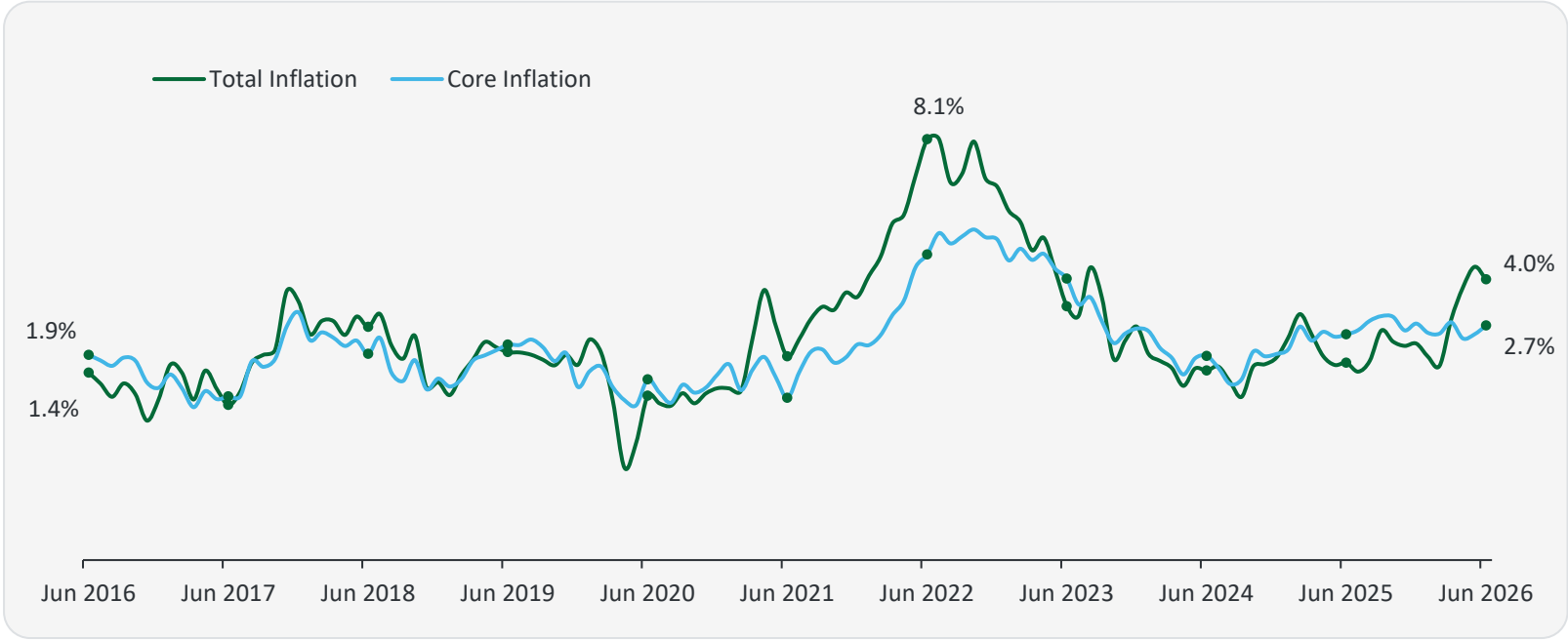
