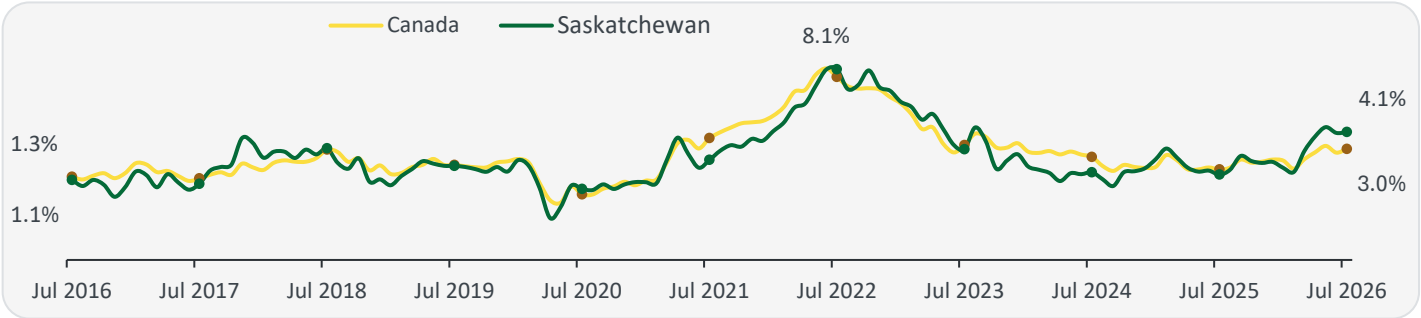

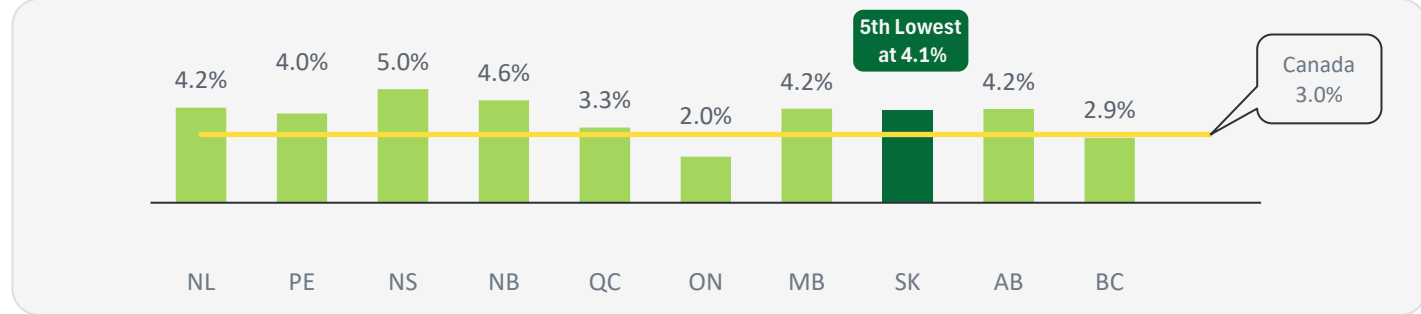

Canada's annual inflation rate was 3.0%	In Saskatoon, the annual inflation rate was 4.1%

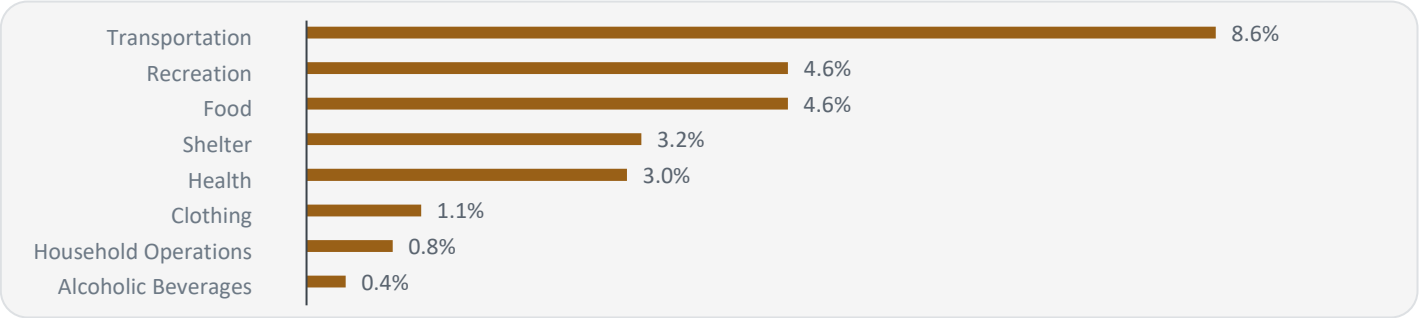
Graph 1: Annual Inflation Rates: Canada vs. Saskatchewan (Jul 2016 – Jul 2026)

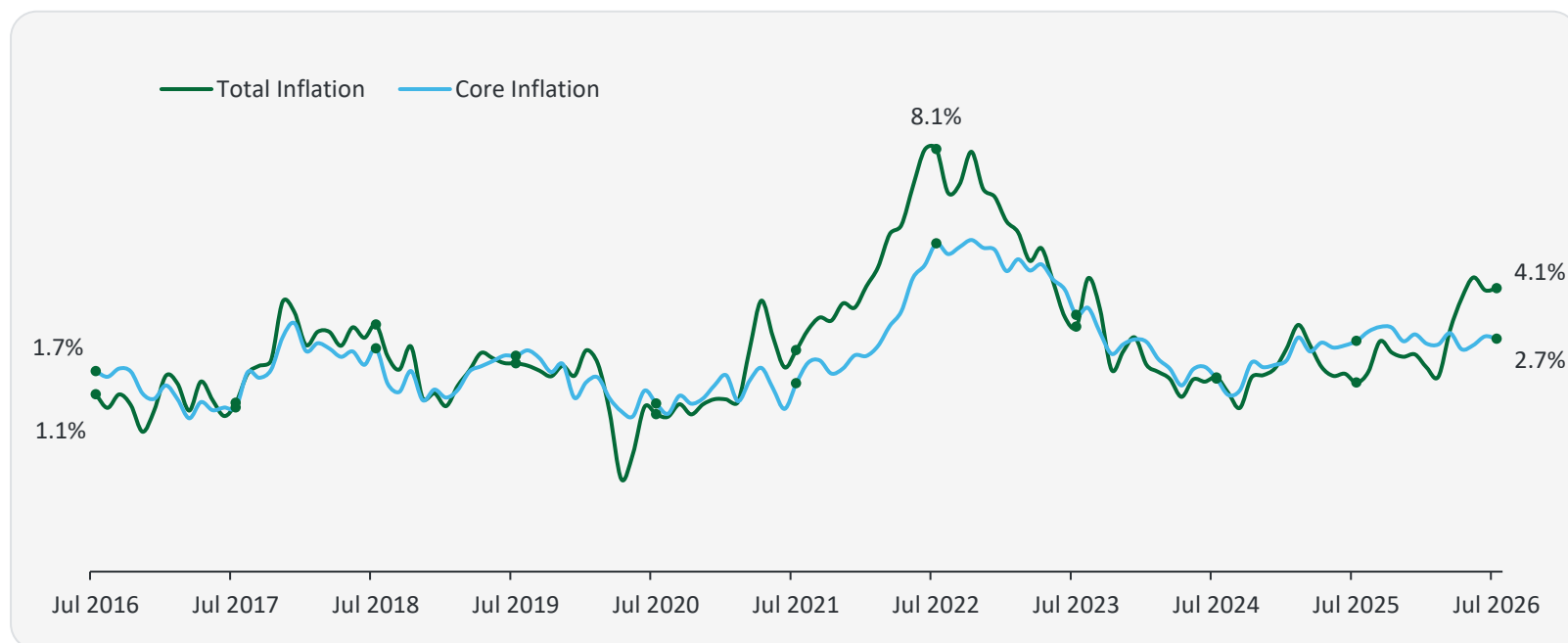
