## MINISTER'S ORDERS

### *The Department of Urban Affairs Act*

WHEREAS, by virtue of section 19 of *The Department of Urban Affairs Act*, the Minister of Municipal Government is empowered to appoint a person as controller to supervise the management of the affairs and business of a municipality;

AND WHEREAS, the Peter Ballantyne Cree Nation has expressed an interest, under The Framework Agreement, in acquiring substantially all of the lands within the Northern Hamlet of Southend for the purpose of having those lands designated as an Indian Reserve;

AND WHEREAS, an acquisition to the extent expressed may result in a reversion of status, or the dissolution, of the northern hamlet;

AND WHEREAS, there is an obligation on the part of the Minister to safeguard and protect the interests of those persons who may remain in any unacquired portion of the community, along with the interests of the Province in that same portion;

AND WHEREAS, certain of the elected members of the council of the Northern Hamlet of Southend are also members of the Peter Ballantyne Cree Nation and may find themselves in conflict in negotiating the sale of the northern municipality's properties and in winding-up the affairs of the northern municipality;

NOW THEREFORE, I, Carol Carson, Minister of Municipal Government pursuant to the authority vested in me by section 19 of *The Department of Urban Affairs Act*, c. D-24.1, do hereby order that Gerald Stinson of La Ronge, Saskatchewan is hereby appointed controller of the Northern Hamlet of Southend to supervise the management of the affairs and business of the northern municipality.

This approval does not authorize the applicant to dispose of salt water without the consent of all the mineral owners, other than the Crown, that might reasonably be adversely affected by such disposal.
