



Who Can Apply

Any student who will be in Grades 10 or 11 during the exchange year and who is currently studying in Core French, French Immersion or Post-Intensive French is eligible to apply.

How to Apply

If you meet all of the eligibility criteria:

- speak to your teacher and school principal about your interest in the program well in advance of the deadline; and,
- visit saskatchewan.ca/quebec-student-exchange to download application forms.

Applications for the Saskatchewan-Québec Student Exchange Program will be accepted until March 20, 2026.

The Opportunity of a Lifetime

Saskatchewan students in Grades 10 and 11 can travel Canada and discover French Canadian culture through this four month Saskatchewan-Québec Student Exchange Program. Saskatchewan students host their Québec exchange partners in their homes and schools from October through November. Saskatchewan students are then hosted in Québec by their exchange partners from February through March.



Benefits

The program gives students a chance to:

- travel across the country;
- improve their knowledge of the French language;
- discover French Canadian culture; and,
- meet new people.

Eligibility

In order to be eligible, students must:

- have consent and approval from parents or guardians, teachers and administrators;
- currently be in Grades 9 or 10 (application is made in Grade 9 to participate in Grade 10 or in Grade 10 to participate in Grade 11);
- have the ability to provide an exchange partner safe accommodations, family life and social setting;
- actively participate in the school community; and,
- have the ability to catch up on school work after a two-month absence.

Cost to Families

The Saskatchewan Ministry of Education will assist with travel expenses to and from Québec. Students and their families are responsible for a \$250 deposit, which is reimbursed upon completion of the exchange.
