

TRANSITION TEAM PROJECT UPDATE

Week of October 16, 2017

This update will provide ongoing information related to the project work underway to transition the health system to a single provincial health authority on December 4, 2017. On occasion this update will include information about work tied to health system restructuring, but not directly related to transition team functions.

ACTIVITIES UNDERWAY:

- The recruitment process for the Saskatchewan Health Authority senior leadership is continuing.
 - Job postings for the first round of available positions closed on Saturday, Oct. 14. The interview process will soon begin for those positions.
 - Announcements will be made as positions are filled.
 - Any new job postings will be posted at healthcareersinsask.ca and mygatewayonline.com, and will be noted in upcoming transition updates.
- On Oct. 12, a meeting of Human Resources and Communications work stream leads occurred, where the teams discussed internal communications needs to support the transition.
 - Work will now occur to ensure a comprehensive package of information is provided to employees, physicians and managers to prepare for and support the transition.
 - The goal is to ensure information is provided to answer key questions across all work streams (what is changing, what is not changing), with a target to share this information in mid to late November.

ACTIVITIES TO COME:

- On Oct. 23, representatives from corporate service lines across the RHAs are presenting recommendations for the Saskatchewan Health Authority to consider in the future.
 - During the spring and summer months, 14 service lines gathered together in facilitated sessions to discuss opportunities for their individual service line as part of the Saskatchewan Health Authority.
 - Each service line then completed a report that outlines its current state, ideal future state attributes and a list of initiatives that would help them move to that ideal future state.
 - This provides the opportunity for service line representatives to present the highlights of their report to the transition team.
