

TRANSITION TEAM PROJECT UPDATE

Week of October 23, 2017

This update will provide ongoing information related to the project work underway to transition the health system to a single provincial health authority on December 4, 2017. On occasion this update will include information about work tied to health system restructuring, but not directly related to transition team functions.

SENIOR LEADER APPOINTMENTS:

Four members of the Saskatchewan Health Authority senior leadership team have been appointed:

- Chief Operating Officer – Suann Laurent from Yorkton
- Vice President Finance and Chief Financial Officer – Robbie Peters from Regina
- Vice President Infrastructure, Information and Support – Andrew Will from Regina
- Vice President Quality, Safety and Strategy – Beth Vachon from Swift Current

These senior leaders will now begin to reach out to Regional Health Authority (RHA) staff within their portfolios to discuss transition and next steps. However, they will not be involved in day to day operational issues until the launch of the Saskatchewan Health Authority. Andrew Will is continuing as CEO at 3sHealth until December 4, to ensure continuity at 3sHealth while he begins to familiarize himself with his new role.

ACTIVITIES UNDERWAY:

- The recruitment and selection process continues for the bulk of the available senior leadership positions, and some senior leader administrative support positions.
 - Announcements will be made as positions are filled.
