

TRANSITION TEAM PROJECT UPDATE

Week of November 13, 2017

This update will provide ongoing information related to the project work underway to transition the health system to a single provincial health authority on December 4, 2017. SENIOR LEADER RECRUITMENT UPDATE:

- Following an open competition process, Kim McKechney has accepted the position of Executive Director of Community Engagement and Communications with the Saskatchewan Health Authority.
 - Kim is joining the Saskatchewan Health Authority from his current position as Associate Vice-President (External Relations) for the University of Regina.
 - He will formally begin working in his new role on December 4.
- The recruitment and selection process is continuing for senior leadership positions. Announcements will be made as positions are filled.
