<b>Title:</b> APPROVAL TO CONSTRUCT, RENOVATE, OR ALTER A FACILITY		

## **INTENT:**

The intent of this policy is to provide direction to regional health authorities and affiliates regarding the construction, renovation, or alteration of a facility, and to outline the specific requirements when requesting approval.

## **LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY:**

*The Regional Health Services Act, Sections 30 and 39*

*The Regional Health Services Administration Regulations, Sections 4 and 9*

## **POLICY:**

A regional health authority or an affiliate shall obtain the approval of the Minister of Health before constructing, renovating, or altering a facility where the cost of the construction, renovation, or alteration exceeds a prescribed amount.

Ministerial approval is required irrespective of whether the regional health authority or affiliate finances the construction, renovation, or alteration of a facility solely from its own funds.

The prescribed amount is \$100,000.

Every regional health authority and affiliate shall submit the following information when requesting approval to constructing, renovating, or altering a facility.

In addition, an affiliate shall indicate whether it has consulted with the regional health authority, as well as the nature of the consultation regarding the above-mentioned construction, renovation, or alternation project.
