after the wind.



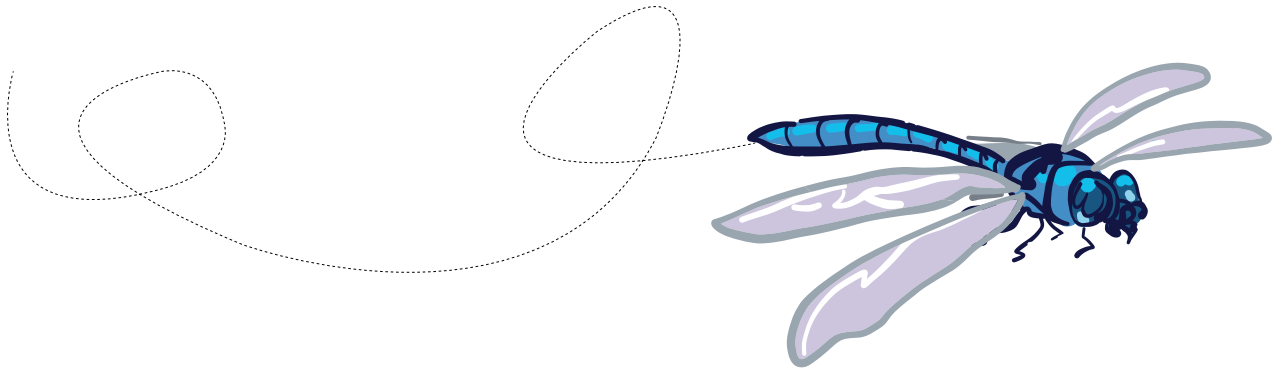
When I go to the pond, I sit in a tree

share stories about what we hear.

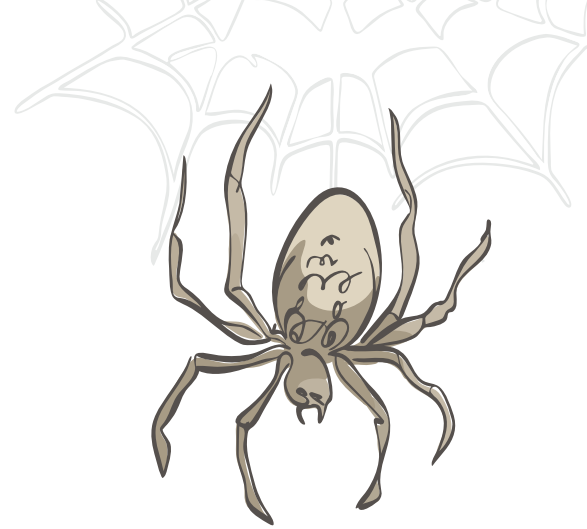
Many of the stories

placed on Mother Earth.

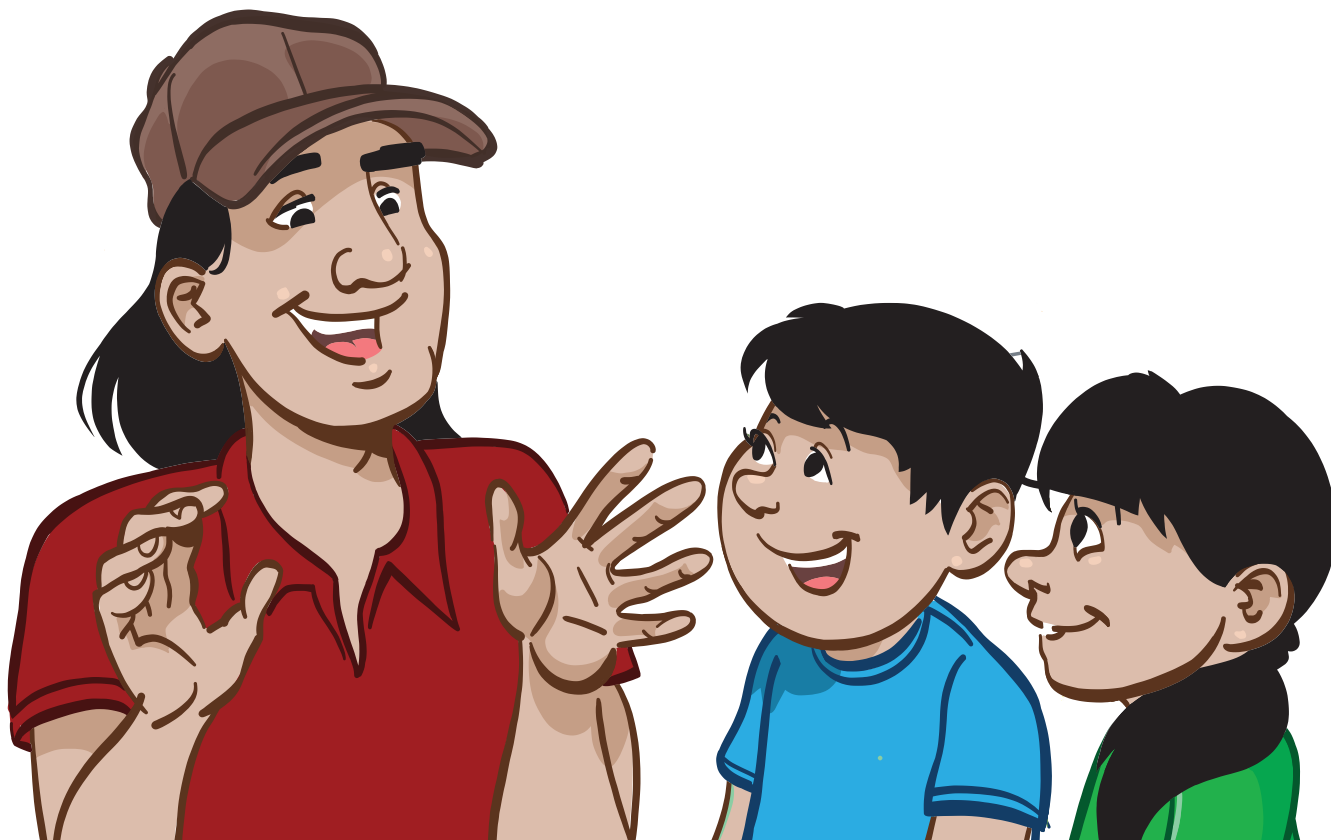
The two-leggeds have learned
