Obligation to Report Core data- Change Due Date

It has come to the attention of the Ministry of Energy and Resources (ER) that the automated IRIS submission due date for the core data elements listed below is not consistent with the *Oil and Gas Conservation Regulations*, 2012 (OGCR).

Currently, the due date for core data elements (obligation WD102) in IRIS is 30 days after the drilling activity end date (i.e. the finished drilling date).

The OGCR requires the core data elements be submitted within 10 days of the drilling activity end date. The new functionality in the March 27, 2019 release, will change the core data elements due date (obligation WD102) in IRIS to 10 days after the drilling activity end date.

The list of the core data elements:

- Core interval top and base (MD and TVD)
- Core type
- Recovered amount %
- missing core interval(s), if applicable
- Depth of core interval within the wellbore from, to
- Slab type
- Box number from, to
- Core analysis done Y/N
- details related to the missing core interval(s), if applicable

Historical WD102 (i.e. core data elements) obligations will retain the 30 days after drilling activity end date, and new WD102 obligations will be given the due date of 10 days from drilling activity end date.

Please note that the <u>submission due date of the physical core itself has not been changed</u> and is due 30 days after the drilling activity end date.
