MINISTERIAL APPROVAL OF A PRODUCT STEWARDSHIP PROGRAM

TIRE STEWARDSHIP OF SASKATCHEWAN INC.

WHEREAS:

- A. Tires are prescribed products for the purposes of clause 46(a) of *The Environmental Management and Protection Act, 2010*.
- B. Pursuant to *The Scrap Tire Management Regulations, 2017* (the Regulations), no first seller shall fail to operate a Product Stewardship Program approved by the Minister of Environment; or enter into an agreement with a person to operate, on the first seller's behalf, a Product Stewardship Program approved by the Minister.

MINISTERIAL APPROVAL is hereby given to Tire Stewardship of Saskatchewan Inc. of Regina, Saskatchewan, hereinafter called the Applicant, to operate a Product Stewardship Program (PSP) in the Province of Saskatchewan in accordance with the following conditions:

- 1. The Applicant shall operate the PSP in accordance with the proposal dated October 19, 2020, titled Proposed Product Stewardship Program for Scrap Tire Management: 2021-2023.
- 2. The Applicant shall advise the Minister of Environment (the Minister) of any changes in content of the PSP upon which this approval is granted and shall obtain prior approval for any such change.
- 3. The Applicant shall ensure the new program is implemented on or before January 1, 2021, as described in Section 1 of the approved PSP.
- 4. Under the conditions set forth in Section 8 of the Regulations, this approval may be cancelled at any time by the Minister if it is determined that the conditions of the Approval not been properly followed.
- 5. The Applicant shall maintain on its corporate website all items identified for update in the PSP including a current list of active first sellers conducting business in Saskatchewan. First sellers listed will be identified as members of TSS and thereby approved first sellers in Saskatchewan.
- 6. The Applicant must develop a greenhouse gas emissions measurement and management plan related to the collection and transportation of prescribed products pursuant to clause 5(2)(b)(xiii) of the Regulations. The plan shall be submitted to the Ministry within six months of this approval for implementation in 2022 and reported in the program's 2022 annual report.
- 7. This Approval takes effect on the date of signing.
