## Ministry of Environment Obligations on Well Licences


The Government of Saskatchewan has enhanced the Well Licence Application process to add functionality for Ministry of Environment to include their obligations within IRIS. Introduction of this functionality will eliminate the Environment approval letter that is currently attached.

There are two different types of Environment obligations that can be added to the licence as required;

- Ministry of Environment Approval Obligations; and
- Ministry of Environment Aquatic Habitat Protection Permit (AHPP) Obligations.

Moving forward, each of these will be included, if required, in the downloadable PDF of the approved licence available in IRIS. The information will also be available on the 'Obligations' tab on the approved well within the Ministry of Environment section.

343177	Pursuant to Section 38(5) of Environmental Management Protection Act (EMPA), 2010 and Section 6 of the EMPA (General) Regulations the licence holder is hereby authorized by the Ministry of Environment to proceed with the proposed project, subject to the following conditions:
343182	The project is to be undertaken in the manner described in the project proposal and any addendums.
343174	Obligations issued under this permit will supersede any commitments made in the project proposal.
343178	A copy of this permit must be available on site and all employees and

343183 Prompt and effective stabilization of disturbed areas is required as soon as possible after construction. Emphasis will be on a rapid return to predevelopment conditions. Erosion control should be consistent with the erosion

hazard and may need to precede re-seeding. Mechanical erosion/stabilization control measures may be required until sufficient vegetation is re-established.

343179 Spill kits, absorbent matting and drip trays must be utilized on site.

343188 Erosion and sediment control measures will be utilized as required to prevent the migration of silt and contaminants into any adjacent river, stream, lake,

creek, marsh or other watercourse or water body.

For the AHPP Obligations, a land location will be entered and an expiry date provided. Please note, that the expiry date for the AHPP may differ from the one-year licence expiry date.
