About

This release implemented 25 items and included updates to the Economic Allowance rates on a well completion's Allowable Rate of Production and the Spatial Data screen of Segment Data Amendment Application. New Disclosure Questions relating to drilling and completion reporting have been added. Business Associate electronic debit codes (EDC) has been enhanced for Public Offerings. As well, various enhancements and fixes to known defects have been implemented to the Well and Facility Infrastructure, Petroleum Tenure and Invoice Modules.

What's changed?

The highlights of what's changed in IRIS as a result of this release are noted below.

Note: Whether a user has access to the functionality or enhancements outlined in these *Release Notes* depends on the individual's security access and assigned permissions sets.

Well and Facility Infrastructure Functionality

- A correction has been made to the reporting requirements for 'Preset Surface Casing' and 'Preset Intermediate Casing' drilling activity. This fix will allow users to report these drilling activities without having to respond to disclosures that are only related to end of Wellbore Drilling activity.
- Updates have been made to the Economic Allowance rates on a well completion's Allowable Rate of Production assignment based on depth as per [Directive PNG012: Allowable Rate of Production: Oil Wells](#). Economic Allowables will now be determined incrementally beyond 3350m. Changes may be noted on a completion's assigned allowable rate; see [TIP](#) for further information on the changes and which completions are affected.
- An update has been made to the Spatial Data screen of Segment Data Amendment Application, which will indicate to the user that they can either optionally provide a shapefile to update geometry if it already exists at the Segment in question, or that it is encouraged to provide the data where it does not already exist.
- New Disclosure Questions have been added to the immediate reporting of drilling and completion, which prompts the user to indicate whether they have conducted Oil, Gas, and/or Water fluid analyses on the well in question. If the user answers yes to any of these questions, a corresponding obligation to submit the data and document will be created. If a user does not

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answer yes to these questions but submits an analysis later, a corresponding obligation will also be created.

Petroleum Tenure Module

- IRIS security for Business Associate electronic debit codes (EDC) has been enhanced for Public Offerings, to assign a random, non-predictable, single use EDC for each Business Associate participating in a Public Offering. Each EDC assigned will be valid only for the Business Associate it has been assigned to and for the Public Offering that it applies to. A new EDC will be created for each participating Business Associate of a Public Offering. EDCs assigned to Business Associates that have not been used will become invalid after the closing date and time of the Public Offering that it was assigned to.

When the Public Offering Notice has been published and the Public Offering has been opened for bidding, the EDC for the Business Associate who is logged in, will display on the right-hand side of the Public Offering Schedule Search screen. The code displayed is the code the user will enter into the Debit Code field during the Submit Bid Application. The screenshot below provides an example of how the EDC will display:
